Call for Proposals: Standards of Good Practice Institute

The inaugural Standards of Good Practice Institute will be held on Wednesday, March 24, 2010 in conjunction with the Forum Annual Conference in Charlotte, North Carolina. The primary purpose of the Standards Institutes is to offer participants the opportunity to broaden and deepen their knowledge and understanding of the Forum Standards of Good Practice and hone their skills in implementing them. While a number of sessions will be led by invited experts both from within and from outside the education abroad field, some

The first Institute, “**Beyond the Basics of Health, Safety and Security,**” will be dedicated to the education abroad risk management issues with which organizations and institutions struggle. The practical, hands-on focus for this day will include multiple concurrent and plenary sessions that will assist participants to improve their institutional and organizational strategies for risk mitigation, incident prevention and response.
