- 7 days later still *Crying* but still in good company



Factors to consider for managed programs

Current Travel

- The unpredictable nature of pandemic
- Availability of healthcare
- Travel can be disrupted or stopped
- Lack of flights
- Rapidly changing border restrictions
- Support for "stuck" students on 3rd party provider vs. direct enroll vs. other experiences

Future Travel & Recovery


- Cancelled all before July 1 (?)
- No unrecoverable deposits
- What is the magic date?
- How does recovery happen?


What to do about students unable to return?
